Jesus is walking with me.*

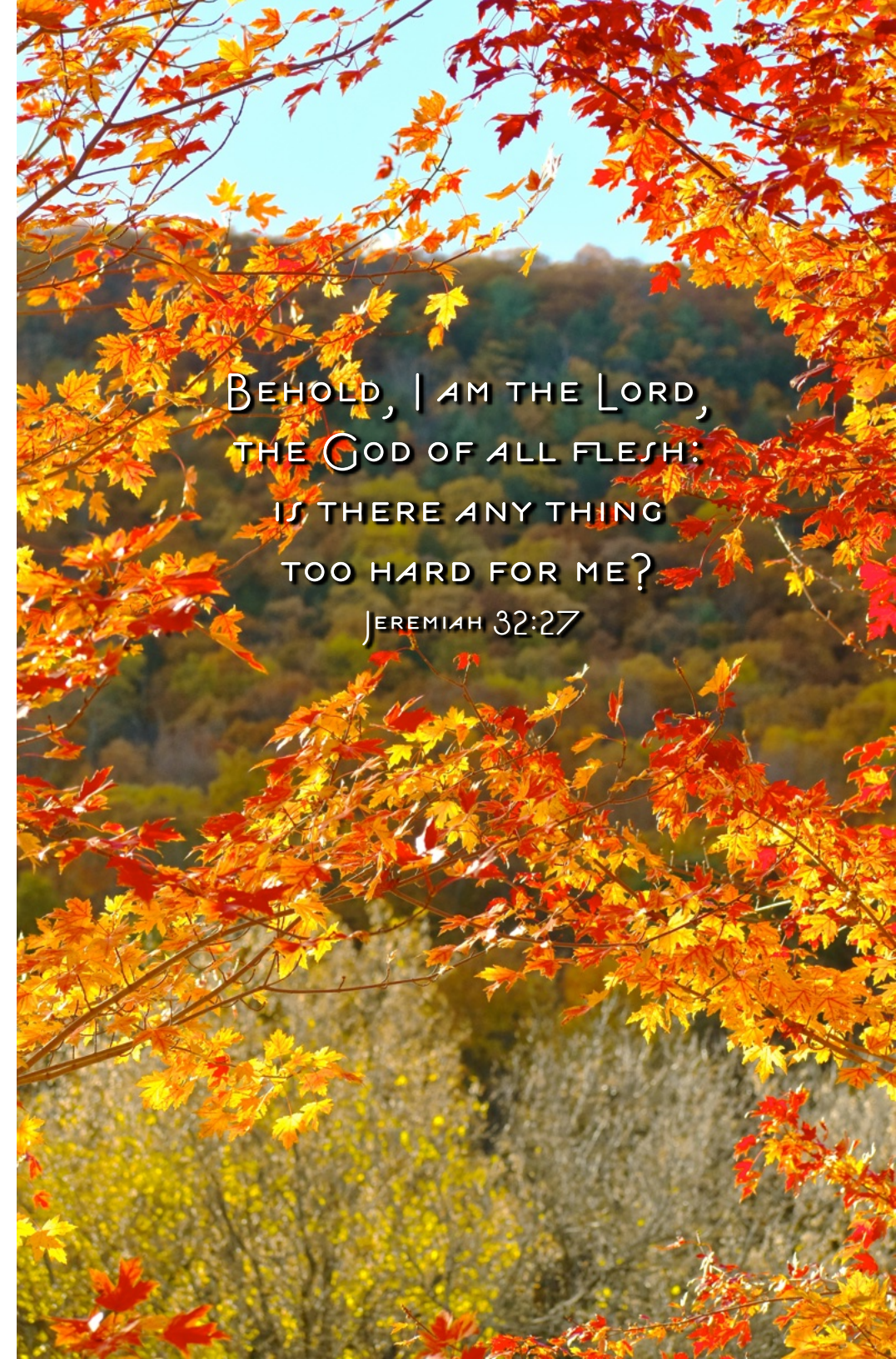
I've laughed on the mountain, I've savored success,
