For all a full atonement made.

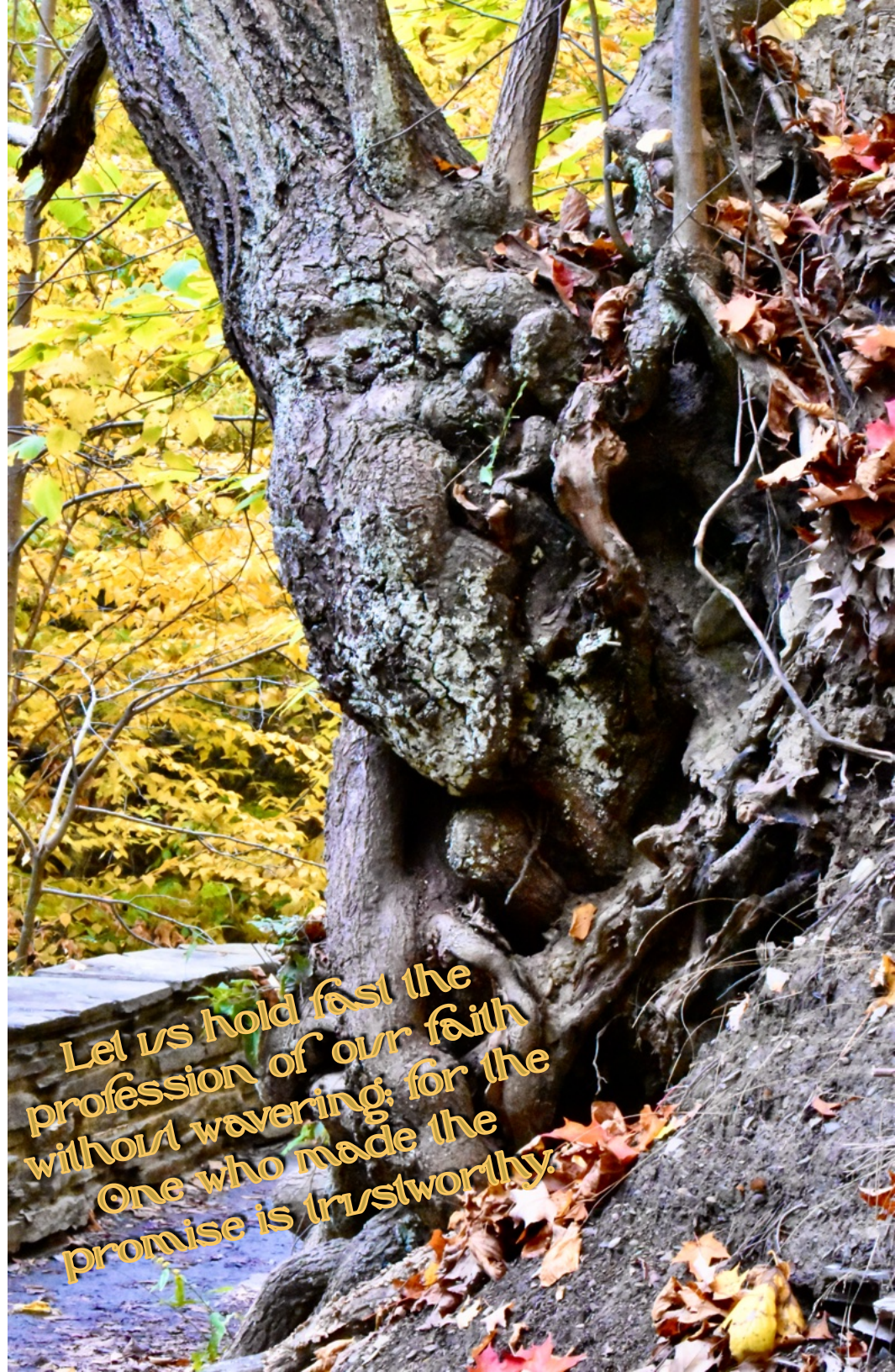




Still He loves to save the sin - ful, Heal the sick and lame,
