This my song through end - less a - ges: Je - sus led me all the way; way.

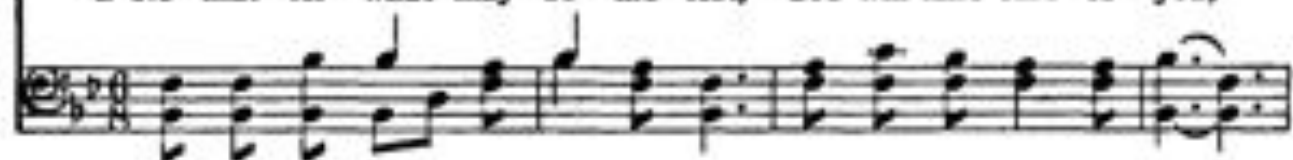
God Will Take Care of You

4. No mat - ter what may be the test, God will take care of you;



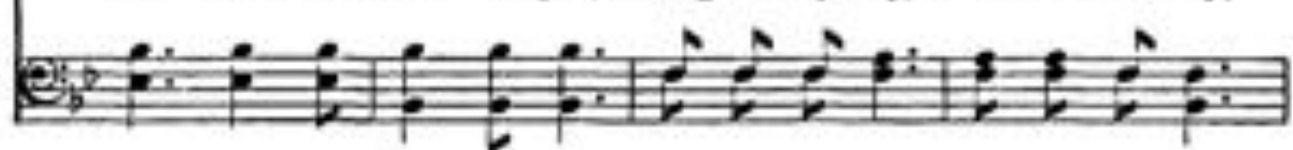
Be - neath His wings of love a - bide, God will take care of you.
