That blest country seems so near.

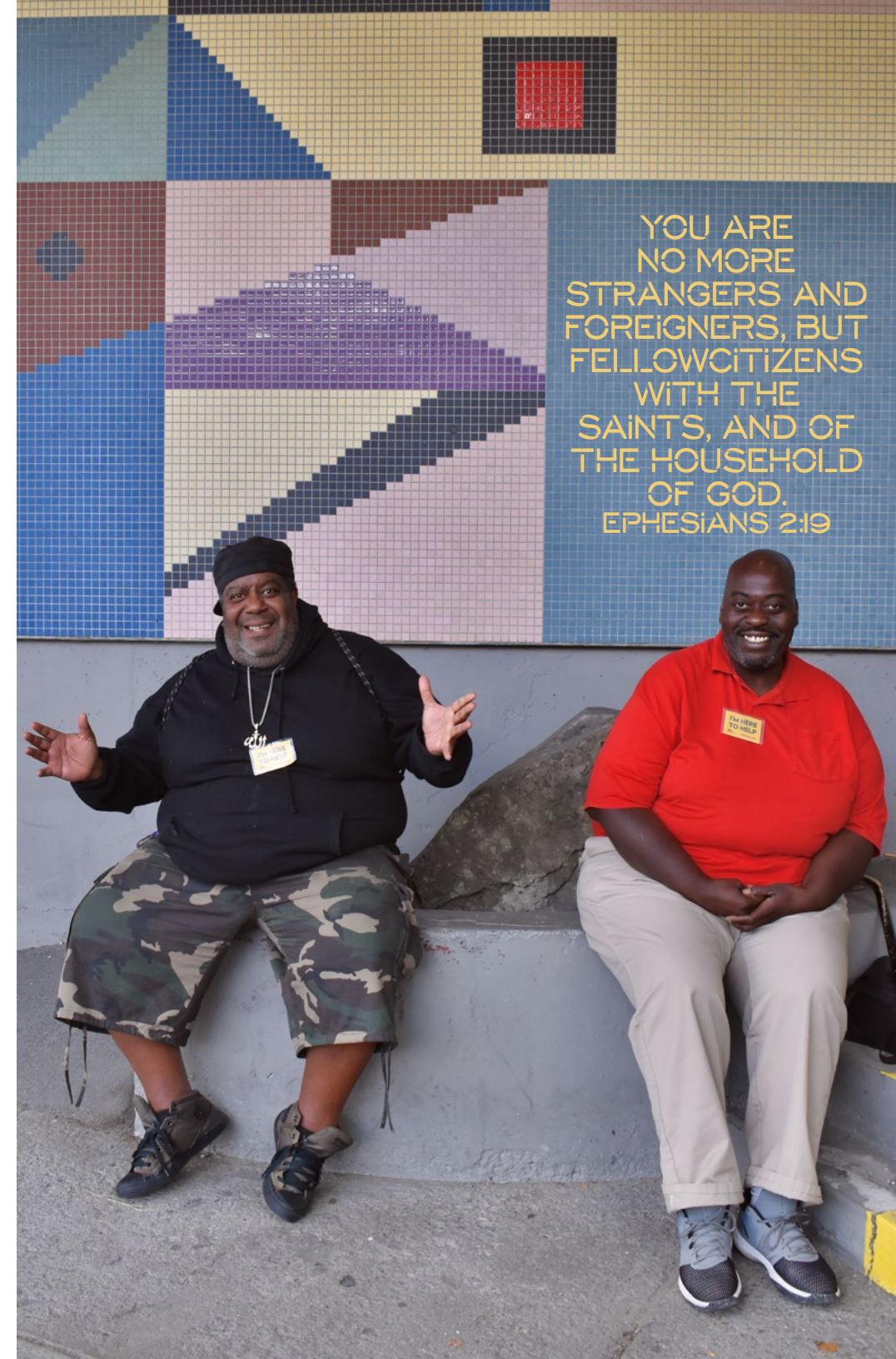
There the stream of life is flowing

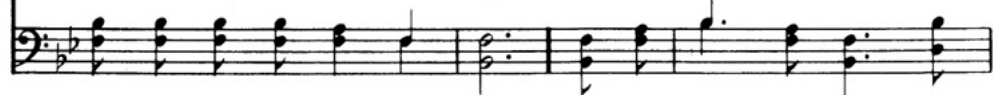
