If you catch yourself thinking this way, repeat this with me:

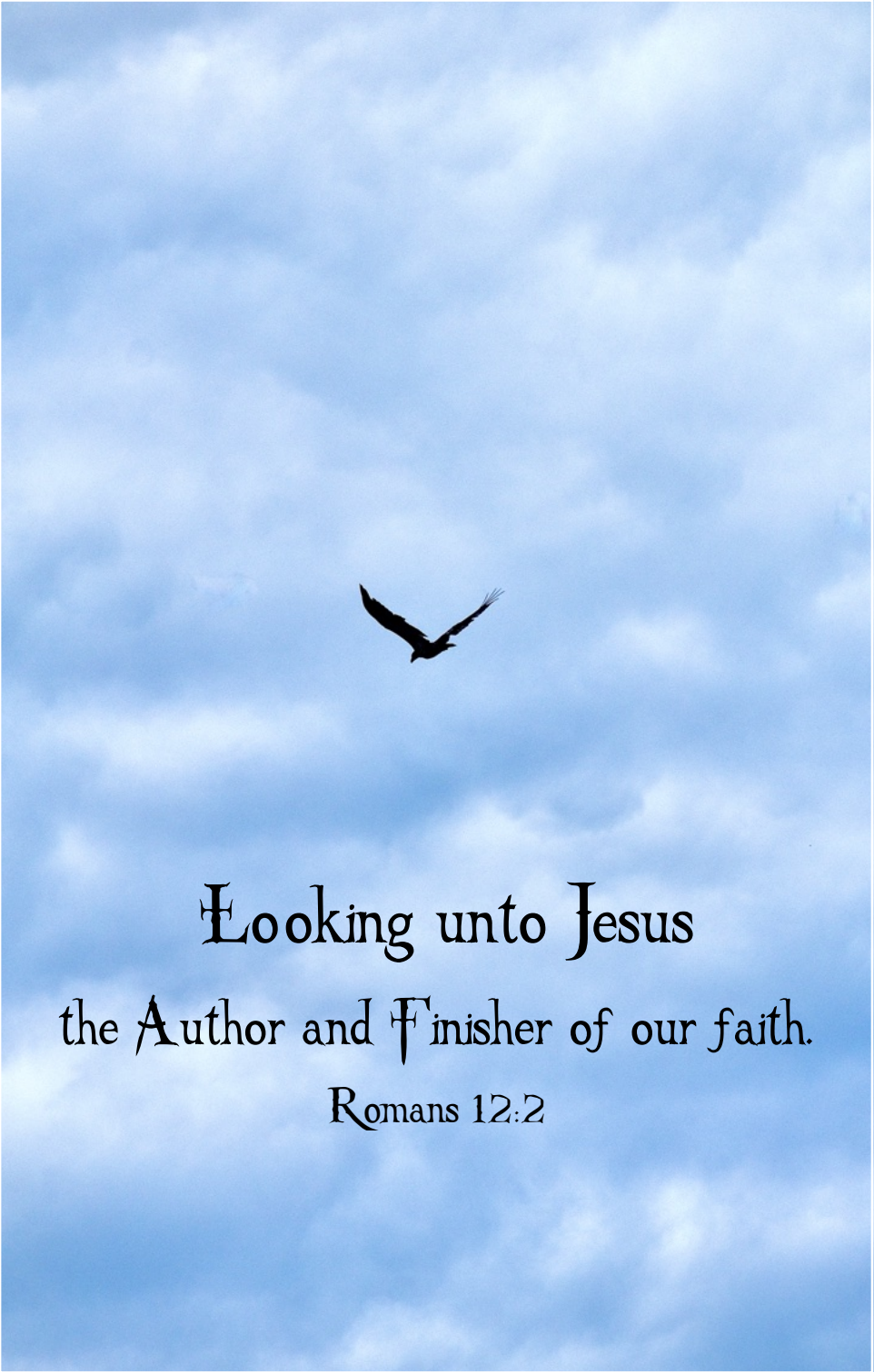
Right here, right now,
